The New Jersey Chinese Cultural Studies Foundation (NJCSSF) - of Overseas Hong Kong Association is accepting applications with the purpose of furthering the awareness of Chinese culture. NJCSSF wishes to encourage and recognize the spirit of individuals whose interests are in advancing the understanding and learning of Chinese Culture. The NJCSSF will give awards/scholarships to individuals that have achieved a certain level of Chinese cultural studies or promote awareness of Chinese cultural.

Criteria (For Scholarship Applicants):

Individuals – General Criteria

- ◆ Must be either New Jersey residents or non-residents who participate in events which take place in the State of New Jersey
- ◆ Immediate family members of NJCSSF or OHKA committee members are not eligible for awards
- ◆ Must be less than 25 years of age
- ◆ Must be citizens or legal residents of the United States
- ◆ Applicants are not restricted by the geographical location within New Jersey
- ◆ Applicants are not limited to Chinese heritage
- ◆ Admitted or enrolled in one of the following institutions of studies:
 - ❑ A course in a subject involved with Chinese studies in any post graduation academic institute such as college or university in NJ
 - ❑ Registered Chinese language school in NJ
 - ❑ Any Chinese cultural related course registered in NJ
- ◆ Must furnish information and costs on a specific course of study, including the qualifications for the course
- ◆ Must furnish personal reference
- ◆ Must furnish transcripts of any school for the past two years, if applicable
- ◆ The evidence of course completion must be furnished at the end of the semester. Without this proof, the student will be barred against future application

Additional criteria based on the type of awards:

- ◆ Individual award:
 - ❑ Family financial condition is not one of the award criteria
 - ❑ The scholarship awards will be presented at the yearly charity event jointly hosted by OHKA and NJCSSF in New Jersey
 - ❑ Must demonstrate an above average in G. P. A. or standardized test scores such as SAT, CAT, etc.
 - ❑ Leadership in extracurricular activities and/or community service involvement
 - ❑ Must furnish written recommendation from teachers and/or community leaders using appropriate letterheads
 - ❑ Must furnish written essay of specified topics
 - ❑ An official application form

The Particulars:

- ◆ For all applicants, please fill out all appropriate items. Applications and all supporting documents will not be returned and will be kept confidential
- ◆ Applicants cannot apply for payment of courses or projects already in progress
- ◆ If applicants withdraw from the course or the institution, all payment must be returned to NJCSSF
- ◆ Must furnish true information, otherwise future application will be turned down
- ◆ May require to interview with committee members of NJCSSF

Application and all supporting materials must be received by the Foundation Committee before:

- ❑ June 30 for the Fall Semester
- ❑ December 31 for the Spring Semester
